Important Reminder: Each calf should receive 2 shots of each vaccine

Follow all directions for proper handling of vaccines and follow this vaccination schedule:

Option 1

1st shot – Weaning

(or shortly after weaning)

Express 5 HS

Presponse HM

*Approved De-wormer (See list below)

2nd shot- Post Weaning

(14-28 days after 1st shot)

Express 5 HS

Alpha 7 or Alpha 7 MB-1

OR

Option 2

1st shot – Weaning

(or shortly after weaning)

Pyramid 5 + Presponse SQ

Bar Vac with Somnus

*Approved De-wormer (See list below)

2nd shot- Post Weaning

(14-28 days after 1st shot)

Pyramid 5 + Presponse SQ

Bar Vac with Somnus

OR

Option 3

1 shot at Weaning with 2nd shot administered 14-28 days post weaning

(select products that cover corresponding viral, clostridial, and Pastuerellas similar to option 1 or 2) + *Approved De-wormer

Approved De-Wormers* *Pick One

Long Range, Eprinex, Ivomec Plus or relative product

Record name of vaccine used, along with lot number on bottle and date administered to be turned in a week before sale day.

Cattle must be weaned for a minimum of 30 days!

This program **does not require** that you have a veterinarian administer your vaccines or sign your health protocols, but you do need to keep accurate records regarding vaccines used and date administered.

For eligibility in the red hided program, all consigned cattle must have at least a 50% genetic base of any of the involved breed's genetics. Sire information and data on calves is encouraged but not required at this time. We ask that all male calves be castrated and healed prior to sale date.

These procedures can be stressful on cattle and are best to be administered at your facility. Completing all procedures when cattle are young will minimize the stress placed on the cattle.

Administering these procedures and following the below tips can assist you in getting the most value for your cattle.

Consign Cattle Prior to a Sale: When consigning cattle prior to the sale, Equity Livestock staff can advertise your cattle in our consignment listing. We are then able to notify potential buyers that your livestock will be available and allow us to get more buyers at the sale. Contact your local Equity Livestock market to consign your cattle.

Provide Veterinary Records: Cattle with veterinary records indicating that they are vaccinated and wormed are more appealing to buyers. Cattle with no treatment or records may sell at a lower price. Consult with your veterinarian for the most effective protocol for your herd.

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
